For this bulletin: Worship

- Majority happy with the services provided. Welcomers are very important each week.
- 3 requests for a formal service occasionally we have had 2 with this focus already since July. Proposed to have one of these services each quarter.
- 5th Sunday to have a different focus each time. Eg young people, prayer and praise/ morning prayer service, formal service, MU service, Mainly Music, family service
- People enjoying the changes of styles and preachers each week and the ministry teams with Lay
 people and Clergy working together. Request for different styles each week- as we move
 forward with practise more variety will be achievable.
- Music is being worked on by the music team: limited by available music and ability to play the
 music. Variety and music following themes have also been the aim.
- Prayers/readings/ welcomers/ sanctuary assistants and morning tea helper's and money counters' positions are being shared more than ever as the rosters are made by the Lay Leaders themselves. Key is to consult with the Leader for the day so that they know who they can call on.
- Lay leaders: week 1 Ross; week 2 Karen; week 3 Davina; week 4 Sue; week 5 Narelle
- NB Please continue to attend worship as you have been doing. It is very rare now that we have numbers less than 40 on a Sunday a great encouragement to us all.
- One problem that COVID -19 has left is the cleaning of the church. We will all need to be aware of the need to help each other.
